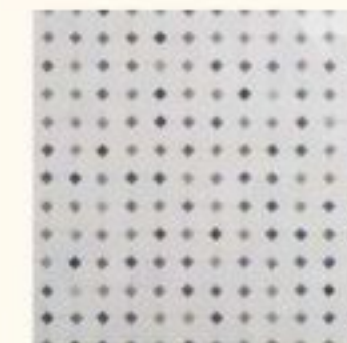

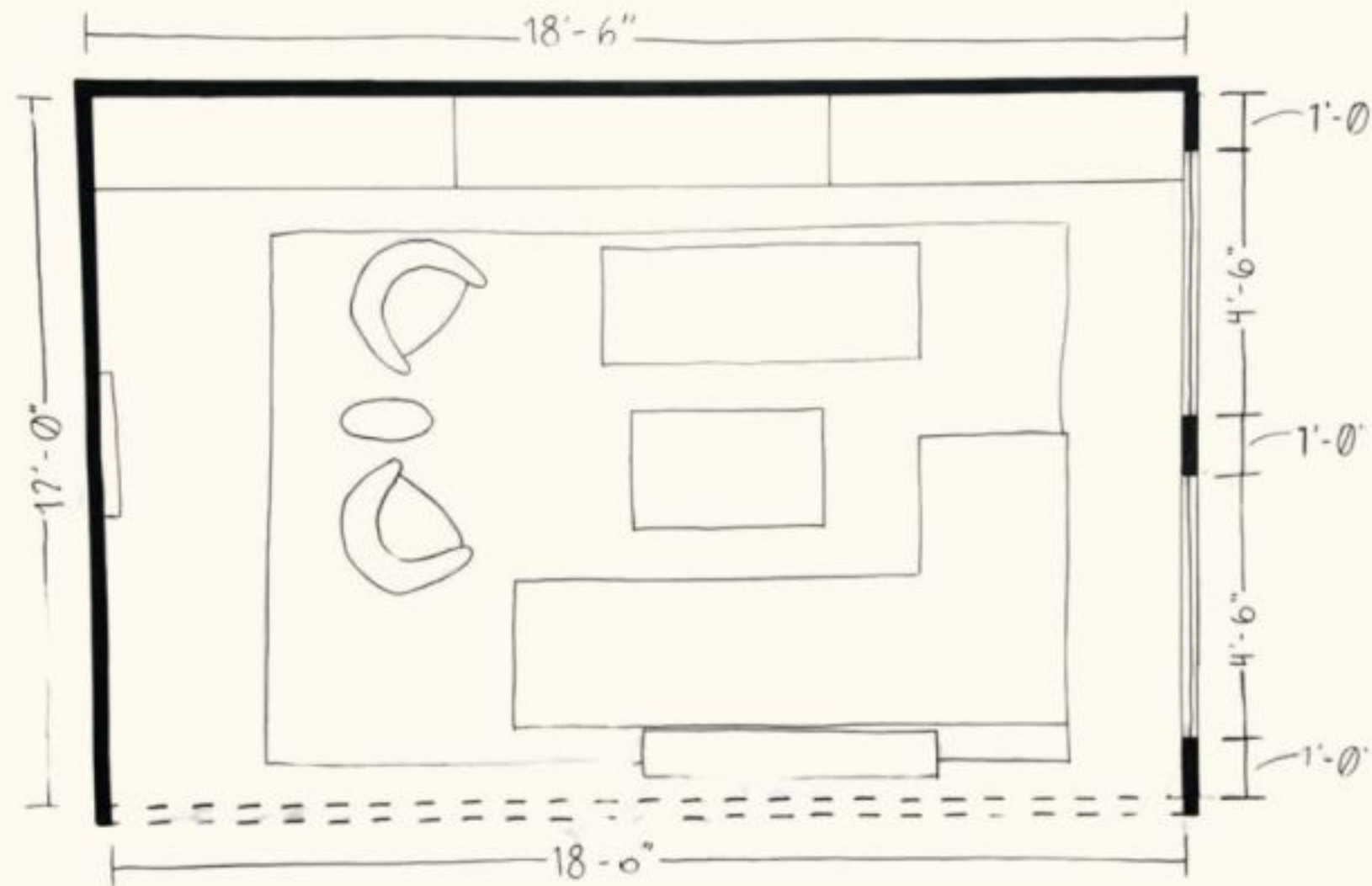

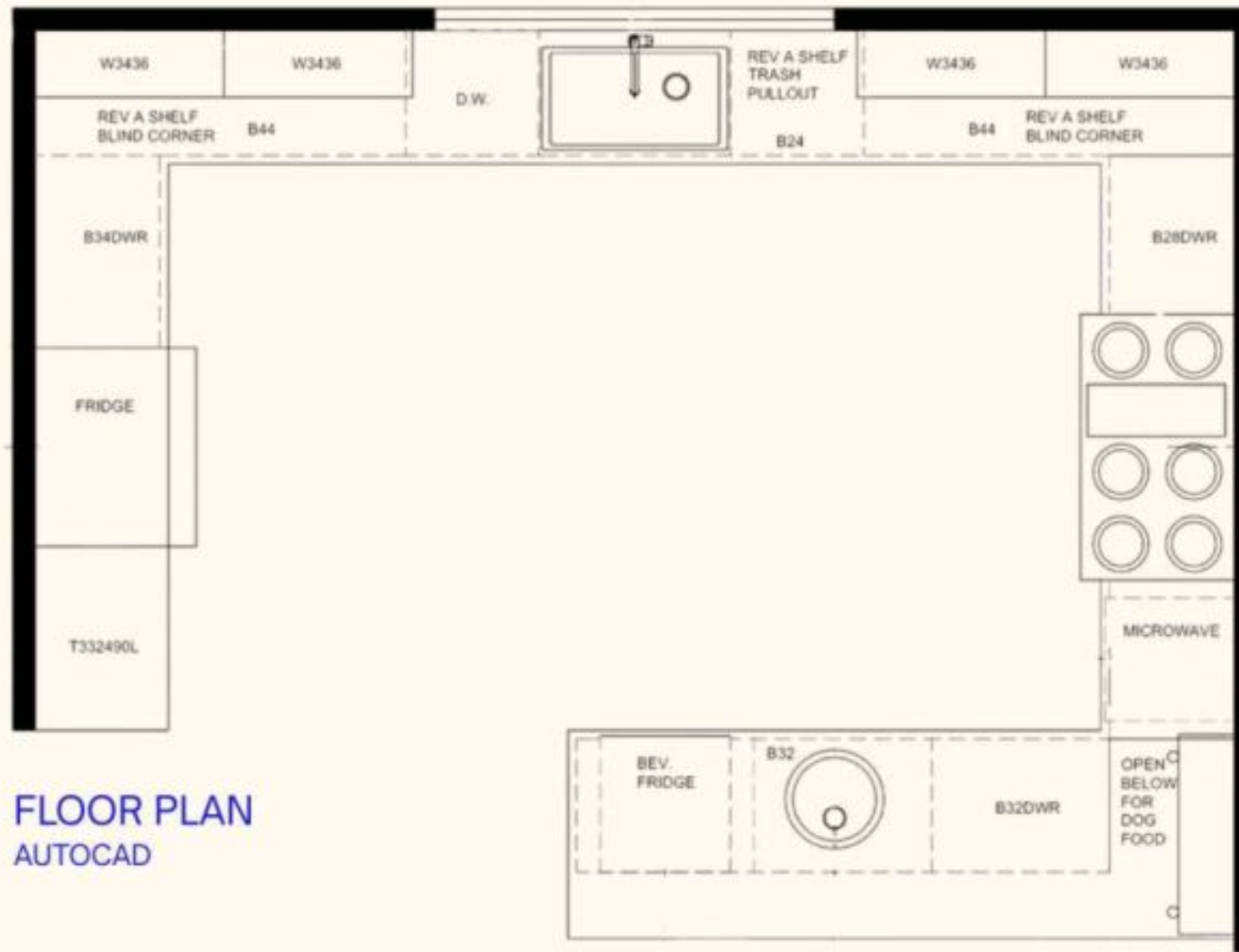

CLIENT INTRODUCTION:

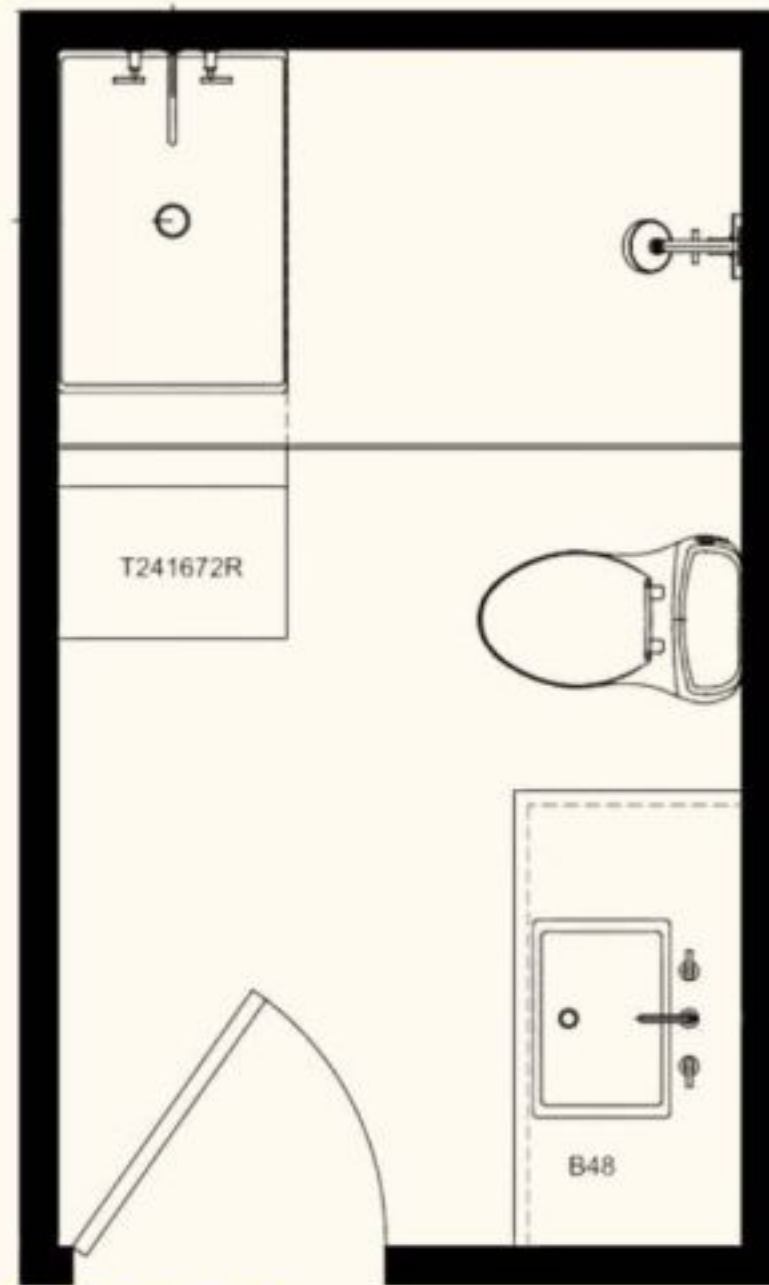

- Smart utilization of space



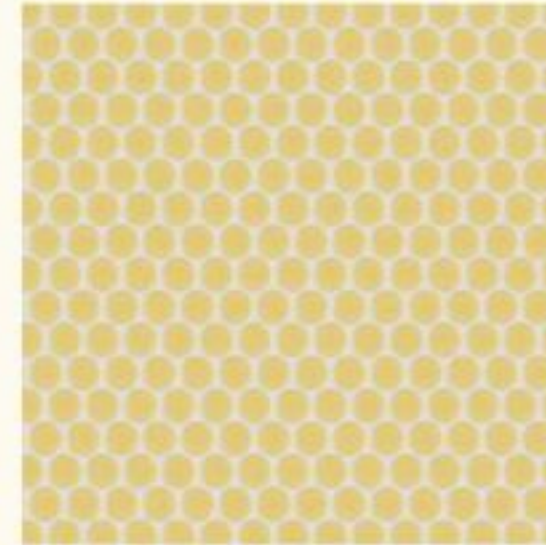

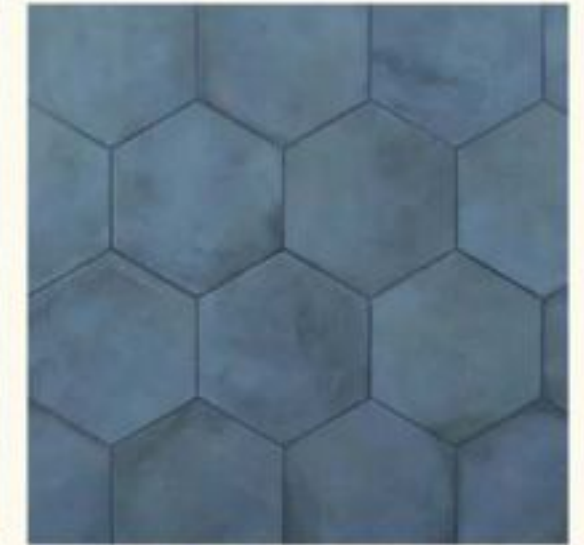

KEY POINTS:

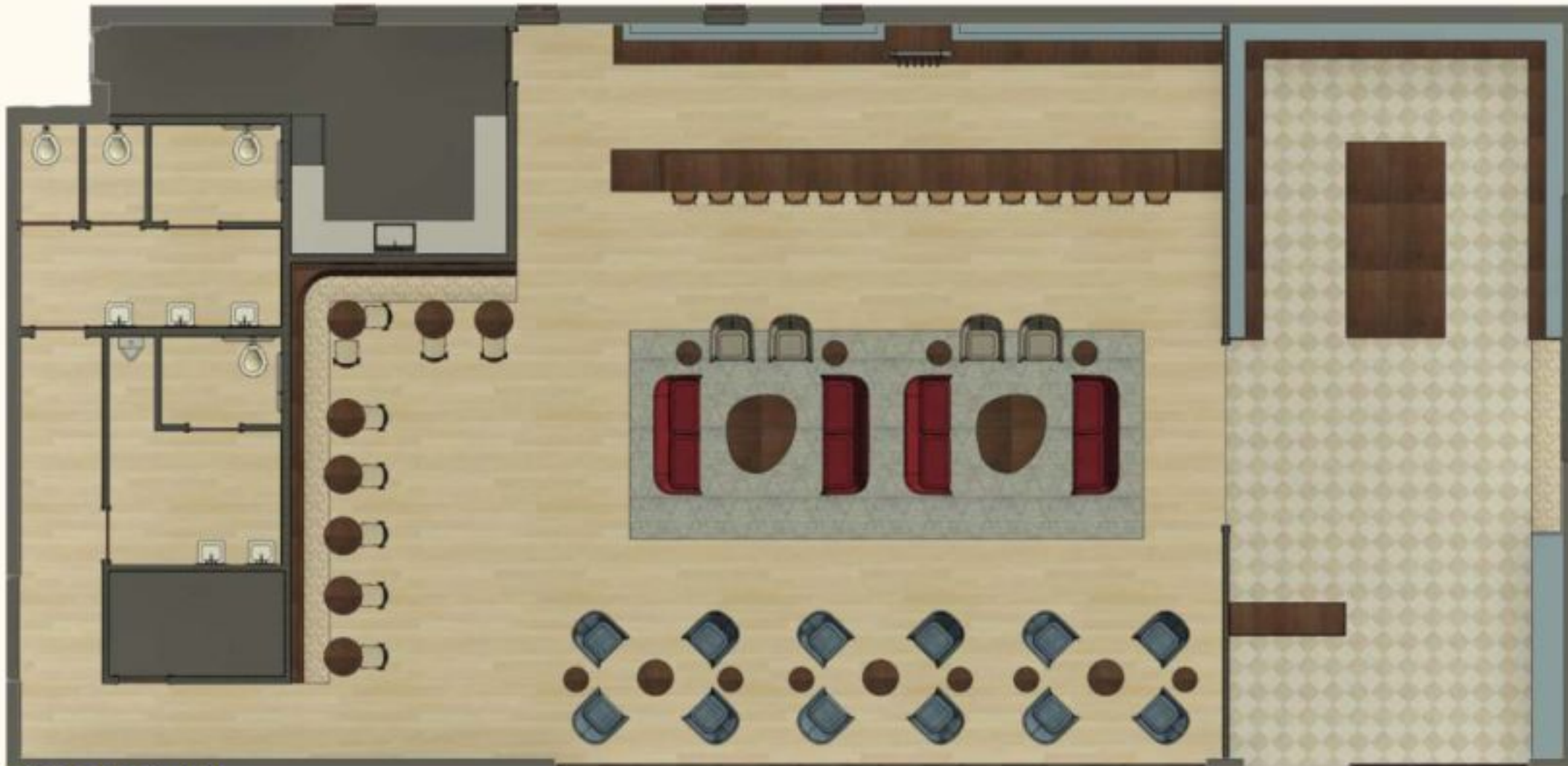
- Kitchen-inspired shopping area

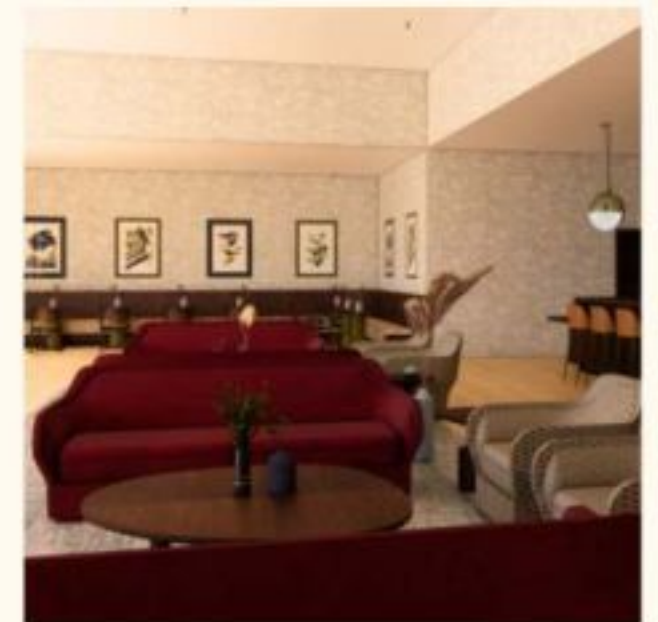
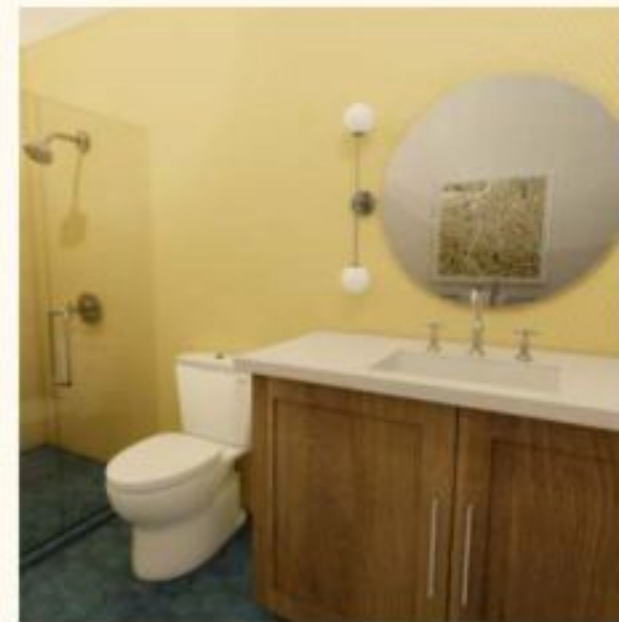
